6) <u>Wyre Council Planning Policy Newsletter - July 2025, for information</u> Green Infrastructure Guidance Update

Wyre Council has updated the <u>Green Infrastructure in New Residential</u> <u>Developments (Policy HP9) guidance</u>. The written statement includes an update to reflect the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and minor editorial changes due to the NPPF (December 2024) update. The guidance has also been transferred onto the Council's new corporate document template.

The spreadsheet/calculator has also been updated due to the contribution per person increasing due to CPI. It allows applicants to calculate:

- The amount of on-site green infrastructure required depending on the total dwellings and dwelling mix (by bedrooms).
- The developer financial contribution for off-site provision.

This guidance came into effect as of 2nd July 2025.
